Frelinghuysen Township receives Sustainable Jersey Grant from Wal-Mart

FRELINGHUYSEN — Frelinghuysen Township announces that it has received a \$10,000 grant from Sustainable Jersey, funded by Wal-Mart, to increase road safety consciousness among walkers, automobile drivers and cyclists along roadways surrounding Town Hall in Johnsonburg. The funds will be used to install new signage, implement a public relations campaign, and maintain the shoulders of the selected roadways. Sections of County Roads 519 and 612, Heller Road, Lanning Road, Mill Road, Main Street, Saddle Ridge Road, Southtown Road, Kerrs Corner Road and Greendell Road will be emphasized, due to their proximity to Town Hall and their high level of use by cyclists and pedestrians. Road crews will be on site within the next few months to install signs, sweep debris, repair potholes, and prune overgrown vegetation. A bicycle parking rack will be installed at Town Hall to accommodate cyclists who use the playground and ball fields. A public relations campaign to communicate details about the project to local residents is currently underway.
