FRENCHTOWN — Appointments were made to the 15-member Green Team Advisory Committee. The committee of concerned citizens is involved in environmental advocacy, including writing grant proposals to gain funding for environmentally-related projects in the Borough.

The individuals named to the Green Team are citizens Sara Rupert, Maria Czarnecki, Craig Czarnecki, Diane Mallon, Michael Filod, Doina Witcher Begin and Dominikija Prosnak; Mayor Warren Cooper; Borough Councilman Gerry St. Onge; Geoff Stanley, a shade tree commission member; Jenny Isaacs, an electric vehicle developer and teacher; Adrienne Crombie, an artist and community organizer; John Mizin, community gardener developer; Richard Reilly, community garden co-developer; and businessman Paul Tomko.

The Borough Council made the appointments at its March 7 meeting. Green Team member tenures end on Dec. 31, 2012.

Municipalities seeking recognition from the Sustainable Jersey organization are required to form Green Teams. Sustainable Jersey towns and cities implement practices that lead to cost savings in energy, water and garbage bills, according to information published on the web site sustainablejersey.com. The program helps communities improve efficiency, cut waste and stimulate their local economies.

Registered towns get priority access and notification of incentives and grants, and are eligible for the Sustainable Jersey Small Grant Program, which funds more than \$200,000 worth of sustainable projects annually across New Jersey.

Goals laid out for the Frenchtown Green Team in 2012 are conducting an audit of municipal facilities, performing an evaluation of municipal fleet vehicles and preparing a report of suggested best practices for "greener" municipal operations.
