February 3, 2017 Small Grants Cycle funded by PSEG



Eligible Expenses

- •Staff salaries and stipends
- Consultant or contractor service fees
- •Supplies, materials
- •Equipment
- Programmatic or educational materials



Use of Funding

\$10,000 grants:

Funds must be used to fund all or part of a project that will score points for an action in the Sustainable Jersey for Schools program.

\$2,000 Capacity Building Grant: Funds can be used for general operating support and direct expenses for Green Teams.



Next Steps

- Get Registered with the program by:
 - Reach out to Union leadership for support
 - Gain support of Principal and PTA to build support/interest
 - Reach out to Superintendent/Board to adopt resolution
- Create your Green Team
- Assess and celebrate existing accomplishments
- Develop a game plan for certification
