Additionally, the schools that receive the most points at the elementary, middle and high school levels will be recognized as a 2016 Sustainability Champion.

The New Jersey Department of Health (NJDOH), through its Maternal and Child Health Services Title V Block Grant, is providing \$120,000 to fund thirty \$4,000 awards to complete specific Sustainable Jersey for Schools health and wellness actions. 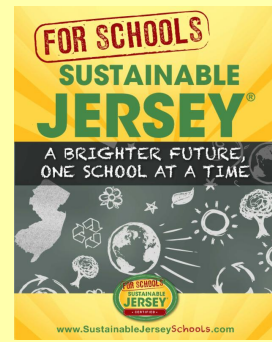
