The New Jersey Education Association (NJEA), as a Sustainable Jersey for Schools program Underwriter, is contributing \$180,000 to support a <u>Sustainable Jersey for Schools Small Grants Program cycle</u>. With this contribution, NJEA has provided \$750,000 to support a sustainable future for children across the state.

The <u>2017 NJEA Schools Small Grants Program</u> cycle will award:

• Ten (10) \$10,000 project grants to school districts and schools

• Forty (40) \$2,000 grants to schools to support green teams

Applicants must be registered in the Sustainable Jersey for Schools program which is free and voluntary. The funded projects will serve as practical and innovative models for the rest of the State and make measurable contributions toward the long-term goal of a sustainable New Jersey.

EPA 2017 School Bus Replacement and Retrofit Rebates

Deadline November 14th

This EPA rebate program encourages school bus fleet turnover so more children can ride buses with the cleanest emissions standards or buses that have been retrofitted to reduce emissions. The 2017 School Bus Rebate Program will provide over \$7 million to public and private fleet owners for the replacement or retrofit of older school buses. Up to \$1 million of the funding total will be available for retrofit funding requests in the selection process.

Grants for K-12 Schools Deadline 5pm ET November 3, 2017

The Nature Conservancy is awarding grants to support projects that implement green infrastructure to address local environmental challenges. These include: access to healthy food, air quality, heat island effect, climate change, and storm water collection. Young people will work as social innovators to help their communities through project design and implementation.

Grants of \$2,000 will be awarded to 60 public or charter schools across the United States. 
