



June 29th Deadline Approaching for Student & Staff Wellness Grants

If your district or school is participating in Sustainable Jersey for Schools and serves students in grades 6 and above, there is funding available to help you implement health and wellness actions.

The New Jersey Department of Health (NJ DOH), through its Maternal and Child Health Services Title V Block Grant, is providing \$120,000 for a <u>Sustainable Jersey Small Grants</u> Program cycle. The cycle will fund thirty \$4,000 awards to complete specific Sustainable Jersey for Schools health and wellness actions. The grant application deadline is Friday, June 29, 2017. Notification of grant awards will be made by the end of August, 2017 to implement actions in 2017-2018 school year.

PowerSave Schools

Get free support and resources to educate students about energy efficiency and save money on your school's energy costs.

Sustainable Jersey is partnering with New Jersey Natural Gas (NJNG) and the Alliance to Save Energy (ASE) to bring the PowerSave Schools program to 32 schools that are within NJNG's service area. Seventeen schools are returning for a second year in the program and

15 additional schools will be admitted for the 2017-18 school year.

NJNG will fund all direct program costs for the 32 schools, while the ASE will lead implementation of the PowerSave program in schools, providing the tools and resources to ensure a successful program outcome.

Carton Council School Carton Recycling Grant Program

CARTON School Carton Recycling Grant Recycling Bins, Lesson Plans & Opportunit in grants available for interested schools! (Rolling Deadline) Recycling Bins, Lesson Plans & Opportunities for up to \$5,000

School recycling programs not only encourage children to learn about the importance of recycling, but they also enable communities to recover large quantities of valuable materials, like beverage cartons. If your local recycling facility accepts food and beverage cartons, we encourage you to consider adding them to your existing school recycling program. If your school does not currently have a recycling program, you can still start a carton recycling one. The Carton Council has resources to help start a program or promote an existing one to ensure everyone is participating. The Carton Council School Carton Recycling Grant Program is designed specifically to help schools across the country establish school carton recycling programs, with the objective of increasing awareness of school carton recycling and ultimately the amount of cartons recovered in a community. Through this program, the Carton Council is able to offer grants up to \$5,000 to school recycling programs that meet the criteria. Milk carton shaped recycling bins are also available free through the grant program. 
