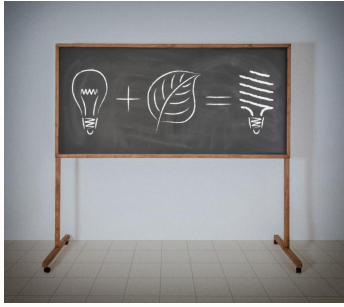
## Sustainability Summit Presentations Now Available

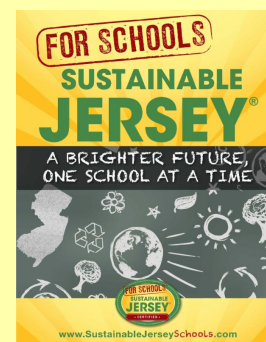

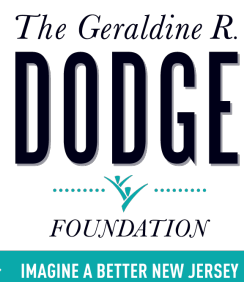
