This session describes how a board member can help lead a school district towards certification in Sustainable Jersey for Schools. A board resolution is not the end of the involvement for board members. In fact, boards can be powerful change agents, by providing guidance through sustainability policy, implementing sustainability in district strategic plans, and creating green district goals. Learn how to align board actions to sustainability initiatives in areas such as the physical plant, hiring of personnel, curriculum, professional development, assessing progress for implementing sustainability, and more.

The Sustainable Jersey for Schools grant program provides opportunities for public schools and school districts to implement sustainability projects. Two grant opportunities are now open through two different funders. Applications are due on **October 31, 2018**.

* \$180,000 in Funding for Sustainable School and District Projects

The New Jersey Education Association (NJEA), as a Sustainable Jersey for Schools program underwriter, is contributing \$180,000 in grant money to fund sustainable projects at the school and district level. This grant cycle will award: ten \$10,000 grants to school districts or schools and forty \$2,000 grants to support school green teams. * \$150,000 in Funding for School District Energy Projects provided by the Gardinier Environmental Fund will be awarded as \$30,000 and \$10,000 grants for energy projects focused on conservation, efficiency and renewable energy. 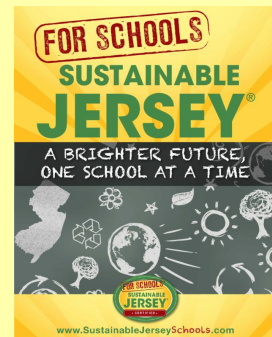

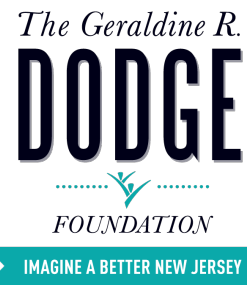
