Bergen	Leonida Public School District	Leonida Public School District	Think Globally, Act Locally: The district will create a Global Citizenship Club to raise awareness of key sustainability issues identified through the United Nation's Sustainable Development Goals. The club will be responsible for multiple efforts including creating a culturally and ecologically diverse garden.
Hudson	Jersey City Public Schools	Number 20 Elementary School	Going Green in Greenville: The school will implement gardening and healthy eating practices into the curriculum by creating vegetable and flower gardens around the school grounds and on top the school's roof. The produce grown in the gardens will be sampled and discussed during class and members of the community will be invited to assist with creating the gardens.
Hunterdon	Delaware Township School District	Delaware Township School District	Greening Cafeteria Operations: The district will work with its Food Services contractor to improve the sustainability of its cafeteria practices and address food waste issues. Efforts will also be made to replace disposable products with reusable products, purchase additional TerraCycle boxes, and integrate food and water conservation education into the curriculum.
Mercer	Trenton Public School District	Trenton Central High School – 9 th Grade Academy	Community Greenhouse: The school will install a greenhouse that includes a community garden and a rain garden. Located in a food desert, the school will use its garden to provide fresh produce to the community while also creating a green space for students. The gardens will be used to enhance the school's sustainability curriculum.

Students will foster STEAM, sustainability, and social emotional learning skills when working together to take care of the fish and plants in the greenhouse.

An on-site composting station will be added to the center along with blue bird houses and nesting areas.

A composting station and rain barrel will be added to the outdoor garden space. Students will learn about the importance of gardening, water conservation, and food waste solutions as part of the curriculum.
